WELCOME

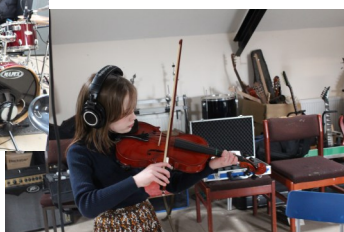

THE NEW KITCHEN



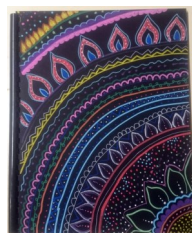

This 12 month project focussed around drama and performance skills; it has now been developed into a Creative Media Club with a strong social aspect and we aim to secure further funding to support it.

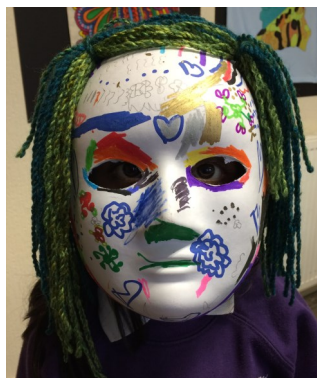
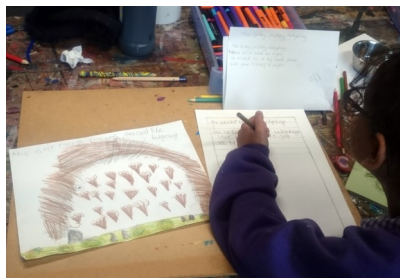
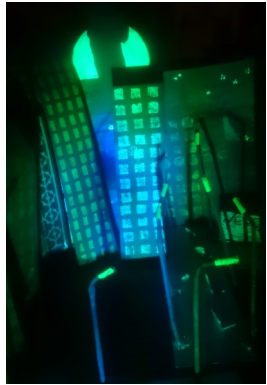
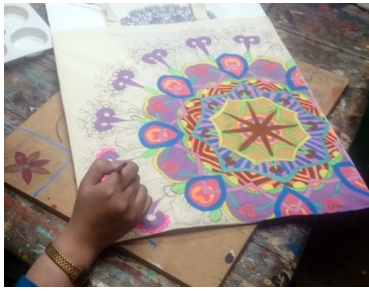
MOVING ON



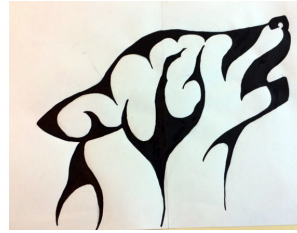
This pilot project ran for 12 months to support 17+ with a range of needs from housing to education to family mediation to social enterprise.
